



Second Harvest Heartland: Food Repacking

<p><i>Background on organization</i></p>	<p>Second Harvest Heartland is a food bank that operates as a wholesaler to local food shelves. Second Harvest collects donated and rescued food in large quantities, then packs and distributes orders to hunger relief partners across the region.</p>
<p><i>Service opportunity</i></p>	<p>Food Repacking volunteers help break the large donations into smaller quantities for local food shelves and other hunger relief programs.</p>
<p><i>What volunteers do</i></p>	<p>Food Repacking volunteers sort, label, weigh and pack various food items meet immediate needs. The projects vary from day to day, but volunteers regularly work with fresh produce, dry goods, bread, and other donations.</p> <p>Volunteers must be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Twist and bend • Lift up to 5 pounds • Stand for the duration of the shift
<p><i>When</i></p>	<p>Westminster will schedule a group volunteer shift once 10 people have indicated their interest. Shifts are available during the day Tuesday – Saturday, and evening shifts are available during the week.</p>
