



VEAP: Food Pantry and Warehouse Stocking

<p><i>Background on organization</i></p>	<p>VEAP (Volunteers Enlisted to Assist People) creates pathways to stronger, more hopeful communities through access to healthy food, housing stability, and supportive services. VEAP's Food Pantry is one of the largest in Minnesota, distributing food to over 100,000 people in the Twin Cities community.</p>
<p><i>Service opportunity</i></p>	<p>Food Pantry and Warehouse Stocking helps keep VEAP's pantry shelves ready for guests. Volunteers sort food donations and prepare items for distribution.</p>
<p><i>What volunteers do</i></p>	<p>Pantry volunteers sort food donations, prepare products for distribution, and stock the pantry for indoor and drive-thru pantry operations. Tasks will vary based on the current needs at the Food Pantry, but examples of tasks could include repacking bulk donations into smaller quantities, packing items such as diapers or snack packs, or preparing items for the drive-thru pantry.</p> <p>Volunteers should be able to lift 20 pounds and stand for a long period (3 hours).</p>
<p><i>When</i></p>	<p>Westminster will schedule a group volunteer shift once 10 people have indicated their interest. Shifts are available during the day and evening and on weekdays and weekends.</p>
